Learn Competitive Defense

You defend twice as many hands as you declare; improved defense can affect your results more than any other single aspect of the game.

The course will be held at the Community #2 Bridge Club (715 Prosperity Farms Road) and will consist of seven (7) ninety-minute sessions. It will be held on consecutive Tuesday afternoons at 12:30 PM; first class is April 8, 2025.

- Common carding and discard systems
- Falsecards that work
- Holdups
- Reacting to squeezes
- Avoiding endplays

Classes will be held on April 8, 15, 22, 29, May 6, 13, and 20.

Registrations close on April 2. A minimum of eight (8) participants is required to conduct the class.
